



Announcement from the Phetchaburi Provincial Education Office  
Policy on Prohibiting the Giving and Receiving of Gifts and Gratuities of All Kinds  
by Government Officials for Fiscal Year 2026

The Constitutional Act on Anti-Corruption, B.E. 2561 (2018), Section 128, prohibits any government official from receiving any assets or other benefits that can be calculated in monetary terms from anyone, except for assets or benefits that are legally entitled according to laws, regulations, or rules issued under the provisions of the law. An exception is made for receiving assets or other benefits according to morality under the criteria and amounts prescribed by the National Anti-Corruption Commission (NACC). Furthermore, the Cabinet Resolution dated December 8, 2020, approved the National Reform Plan on Anti-Corruption and Misconduct (Revised Version), which mandates the implementation of key reform activities (Big Rock). Reform Activity 4 aims to develop the Thai bureaucratic system to be transparent and free from conflicts of interest, with the first goal, item 1.1, stating: "All government agencies must declare themselves as agencies where all government officials do not accept any gifts or gratuities of any kind in the course of performing their duties (No Gift Policy)."

Therefore, to promote anti-corruption measures and misconduct prevention in the public sector, and to demonstrate our commitment to combating all forms of corruption, as well as to foster a culture and values of integrity in performing duties with ethics and without conflicts of interest, the Phetchaburi Provincial Education Office has established a policy that designates the office as an entity where all government officials do not give or receive any gifts or gratuities in the course of their duties. The executives, officers, and personnel of the Phetchaburi Provincial Education Office are to strictly adhere to this policy.
